## Workforce Development

Youth services include basic education, tutoring, academic support, comprehensive guidance counseling, mentoring, leadership development camp, paid and unpaid work experience, summer employment opportunities, occupational skills training, preparation for post-secondary education, and supportive services. Must be at least 16.

Participants for both programs must be income eligible. Youth program age 16-21.
